### WASHINGTON STATE UNIVERSITY ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT (ETM)

This professional-level program, part of the ETM Master's Degree, empowers employees to advance their careers and helps companies increase their competitiveness, profitability and market share. Eligible students can enroll as a graduate (G) or advanced undergraduate (U) in just one course; or complete a set of four defined courses to earn one of the following certificates:

- Project Management (G,U)
- Six Sigma Quality Management (G,U)
- Manufacturing Leadership (G,U)
- Constraints Management (G)
- Logistics and Supply Chain Management (G)

### HOW DOES IT WORK?


*Make it in Washington* offers you the opportunity to build your manufacturing business and improve your workforce at the same time.
