## Our Building Blocks a Collaborative Process


- 1. Major decisions on plan decided by Workforce Board** in collaboration with workforce partners
- 2. WIOA Steering Committees, Subcommittees and Taskforces** – the resource well and driver of plan priorities
- 3. State Plan Writing Team** – comprised of major workforce partners with all stakeholders welcome to attend weekly meetings (Team draft sharing—started October 19<sup>th</sup>)

## Plan Building Blocks (continued)


4. **Public Forums Phase 1** – provide overview of draft plan's priorities and receive input and recommendations
5. **Operational Plan Team** work sessions start on October 23rd
6. **Ongoing Support for Local Plans** with official guidelines targeted in early November


Seattle— approx. 100 participants

# Q1: Overall, how would you rate the event?










